Competition Information

Facility	Centennial Pool 3050 Chester Street (corner of Shaughnessy St. & Lougheed Hwy in Aggie Park). Port Coquitlam, BC
Dates	Saturday, June 6 to Sunday, June 7, 2026

Eligibility	Open to all registered BCSSA members for the current season. Swimmers may enter up to 4 individual events and 2 relay events. Divisions determined by the Age locator provided by BCSSA.
Format	Regular BCSSA meet with no separation of Seniors and Juniors into different sessions. This year there will be no 200IM for the Seniors but will have 100IM only with Time Standards and additionally 50m Back and 50 Breast for Seniors. The events will be separated via gender and open groupings into Juniors (Div 1 to OCat 1) and Seniors (Div 4 to OCat 8, including Masters OCat 10). All events are timed finals .
Individual Races	<u>Individual races</u> will feature normal-seeded per division and separated by gender.

Relay Races

- Relay slips for each day must be presented to the Meet Office support by 10:30AM and entries must be on the Official Relay Entry Form or reasonable facsimile
- Girls and boys relays for divisions 1 to 4 must have four "S" swimmers.
- Girls and boys relays for divisions 5 to 7 and O Cat 8 (including Masters) may have any combination of "S" and "O" swimmers.
- O Cat 1 relays must have a minimum of one "O" swimmers.
- **On Saturday - 100 m family relay, each swimmer swims 1 length of the pool - relay can be made up of 1-2 families (combination of immediate family members and other BCSSA swimmers). The relay may be deck entried on Sat.**

Development Races

25 meter freestyle and backstroke development events are open to all members in division 1 and under and they cannot participate in both 50m and 25m (only 1). The swimmers must be able to swim the length without any assistance (coach or flotation aids).

Warm Ups

Warm-ups run from **6:45am to 8:15am.**

Lane assignments will be emailed to the participating clubs ahead of the meet.

Officials

All clubs are expected to supply senior deck officials as well as junior/intermediate stroke and turn officials during the meet. Signups for these positions will be made available near the marshaling area.

There will be **one official meeting per day**. It will take place at **7:30am** near the announcer's desk.

Coaches

- **Coaches must be on deck for warm up**
- Times and lanes for warm ups will be assigned after official entries are received. They will be emailed out a couple of days before the meet. At the meet they'll be on the announcers table board at the north end of the pool.
- Coaches Meeting will be held at **7:45am**

Rules

The latest BCSSA Rules and Regulations are in effect and will be strictly enforced with the exception of the 25 meter development events.

Timing System

Colorado Electronic Timing System with electronic touch pad and buttons interfaced with the Hy-Tek Meet Manager and a six line display scoreboard will be used as the approved automatic judging and timing system in accordance with the BCSSA rules.

Awards/Prizes

For individual races, divisions 1 to 7 swimmers will receive 1st to 6th place ribbons.

Total Aggregate points will be calculated and Gold, Silver and Bronze will be awarded to the top 3 pointer earners, **up to 4 individual events** will count towards total aggregate points. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals to the top 3 aggregate point totals in each division with at least 4 swimmers who swim 4 individual events each. Medals will be awarded after individual events on Sunday. Actual medals for upper divisions may not be available at the time due to a shortage (they will be sent later).

Prizes will be awarded for swimmers during "bell races".

This year is the Mantas' 40th Anniversary, and swimmers who record a race time containing "40" (e.g., 1:40.26 or 33.40) can claim a special prize at the Mantas booth. Please bring proof of your official race time when claiming your prize.

Marshaling

There will be marshaling for divisions 1-3 and O Cat 1 on both days.

We will be marshaling for all divisions 4-7 and O Cat 2, 8 on both days.

Courtesy marshaling calls will be made by the announcer.

Results

Results will be posted on a wall, in Meet Mobile and emailed to attending club representatives.

Volunteers

Each participating club is required to provide at least three timers and officials for each shift. Smaller clubs (18 entries or less) may be delegated shared responsibilities. Refreshments will be provided for all volunteers, officials and coaches. **Dietary restrictions will not be accommodated. Everyone is encouraged to bring water bottles to reduce waste.**

Facility Information

Pool

6 lanes, 25 meter outdoor pool(short course competition).

Viewing

Spectators will only be able to view from the designated spectator viewing areas.. Spectators\Parents are also not permitted on the working pool deck and in the marshaling area.

Tenting

Tenting will be available in Aggie Park. Ample tent space available for daily use but there is no security for leaving tents overnight. Refer to the map on the last page.

Cooking

Cooking is permitted as per municipal regulations at the time of the event.

Change Rooms

Available in the facility. There will also be porta-potties available outside the fenced in pool deck.

Food

There is deck food and a concession stand at this event. Cooking is allowed in the park as per City of Port Coquitlam guidelines - assuming no fire restrictions at the time of the meet.

Parking

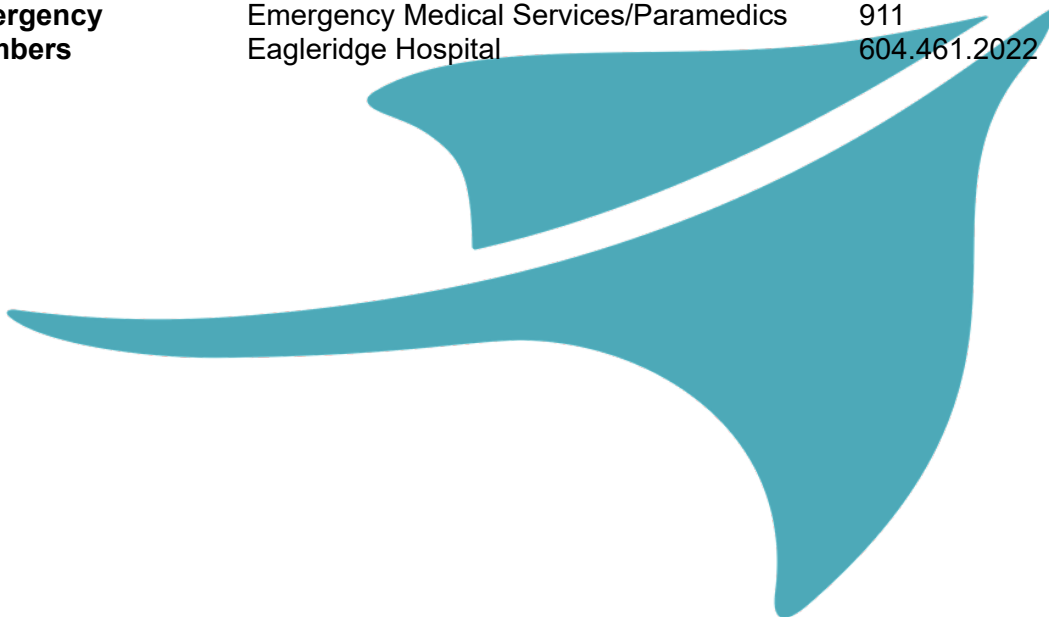
Parking is adequate but important restrictions apply

Entry Information

Fee	\$8.00 per individual event \$10 per relay team
Events	Swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual races and 2 relays (one per day). Swimmers in Div 1 may enter either the 25-meter or the 50-meter events but not both distances of the same stroke.
Submission	A complete meet entry package must be sent to the Meet Registrar (competition@burnabymantas.ca) on or before May 27, 2025 and shall include the following: • An Exported meet entry file, roster file from Hy-Tek Team Manager. Swimmers' best times must be current as of May 1, 2026 and must be entered. • For event 110-111 (100 I.M.), no NT will be accepted. Swimmers must be able to compete with following time standard: Division 1 - O Cat 1 = 2:30 • A cheque made payable to Burnaby Mountain Mantas Swim Club. • Contact information (phone number and email address) for your club's Director of Officials, meet entry person and the results/awards contact person.
Deadline	Entry package must be in on or before June 2, 2026 for inclusion in the heat sheets and programs.
Swimmers	All swimmers must be registered with BCSSA. Swimmers must be entered in their age-appropriate division as the BCSSA age locator. Swimmers will not be allowed to "swim up" in higher divisions or "swim down" in lower divisions for their individual events.
Deck Entries	Deck entries will not be accepted on the day of the swim meet.
Scratches	All scratches prior to the meet must be submitted by 7:25 am on the day of the event. There will be no refunds on scratches. Scratches on the day of the meet must be made to the Office / Meet Registrar as soon as possible.

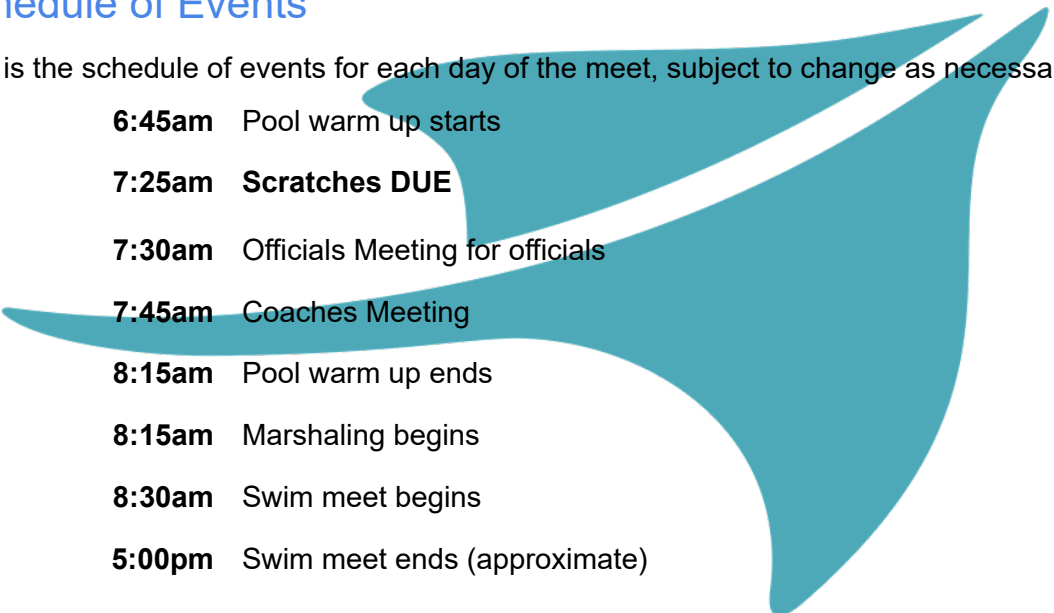
Confirmation

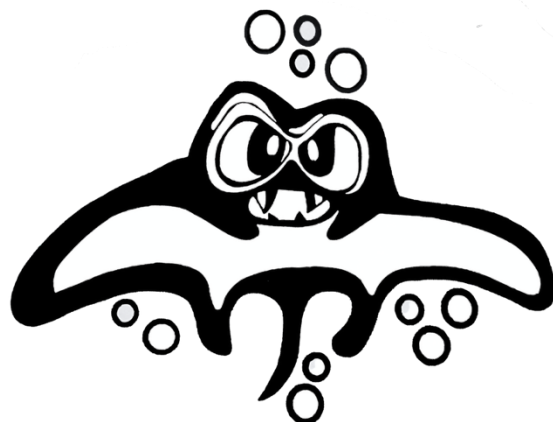
